All About Me	 By the end of this topic pupils should be able to: Give extended sentences to describe their personality using connectives and quantifiers. Say how many people there are in their family and use opinion phrases to describe them and their personalities. Be familiar with the subject pronouns (Je,tu, il, elle, on, nous, vous, ils, elles) and recognise the conjugations of être with these different pronouns. 	Formative Assessment – Written piece about family and personality. Dictation exercise.
Pets	 By the end of this topic pupils should be able to: Understand the difference between the different indefinite articles in relation to pets. Talk about what pets they have and /or pets they would like. Use the subject pronouns with the verb 'avoir' Describe things in more detail using colours and adjectives, which are positioned correctly in the sentence and agreed with the noun. 	Speaking Assessment – Describe a picture, understand and respond to questions about how they are feeling, their personality, their family and pets.
The Present Tense	 By the end of this topic pupils should be able to: Feel confident using the subject pronouns. (Je, tu, il, elle, on, nous, vous, ils, elles) Understand the difference between an infinitive and conjugated verb. Recite a number of infinitives ending in 'ER' 'IR' and 'RE'. Use the rules to conjugate regular verbs with all the different pronouns in the present tense. 	Grammar Assessment – Gap Fill Exercise where pupils have to find the correct version of the conjugated verb or conjugate it themselves.
Hobbies	 By the end of this topic pupils should be able to: Use conjugated regular verbs in the present tense to say which hobbies they have and the hobbies of others. Use opinions with infinitives to how they like and dislike certain activities. Use adverbs of frequency to say how often they do an activity. 	YEAR 7 ASSESSMENTS – Reading Assessment – Comprehension questions both multiple choice and open response. Listening assessment – Pupils hear texts and answer questions about them.
Food and Drink	 By the end of this topic pupils should be able to: Conjugate 'manger' and 'boire' in the first and third person. Talk about what they eat for different meals of the day using adverbs of frequency. Conjugate 'aller' in the present tense and use it followed by an infinitive to use the near future tense. 	Writing Assessment – Describe a picture, answer questions about their hobbies and what they like to eat and drink and what they are going to eat for a meal tomorrow.
