TOPIC	KEY LEARNING	ASSESSMENT
The Present Tense and My Personality	 By the end of this topic pupils should be able to: Conjugate regular 'ER', 'IR' and 'RE' verbs as well as 'aller' and 'être' in the present tense with all subject pronouns. Feel confident in spotting mistakes in their own work when it comes to the accuracy of present tense verbs. Talk about their personality in detail using a wide range of adjectives, connectives and opinion phrases. Use comparatives to compare their personality with others. Use the imperfect tense to talk about when they were younger. 	Formative Grammar Assessment – Conjugating verbs in the present tense. 'Grammar gap fill and spot the mistake' style questions.
My Family and Friends	 By the end of this topic pupils should be able to: Describe their family members in detail, both physically and their personalities and give opinions. Talk about the family relationships using the reflexive verbs 's'entendre', 's'amuser', se disputer'. Use the modal verb 'devoir' to talk about the qualities of a good and bad friend. To say whether they believe they are a good or bad friend and why. 	End of Topic Assessment – Module 1. Listening, Reading and Writing Assessments.
Free Time	By the end of this topic pupils should be able to: Conjugate the verb 'faire' in the present, past, future and imperfect tense. Say which hobbies they currently do, have previously done and will do in the future. Talk, in detail, about their reading habits using different time frames, adverbs of frequency and justified opinions. Describe a memorable weekend using a variety of verbs in the perfect tense.	Formative Assessment – Writing assessment on Module 2. Describing a picture, 130-150 word response and translation. Modelled in class and peer assessed.
Technology	 By the end of this topic pupils should be able to: Understand topic specific vocabulary on the theme of technology and computing. Talk about their use of technology in everyday life using past, present and future tense. Discuss, in detail, the advantages and disadvantages of technology and social media using justified opinions. Describe the everyday dangers of technology and give advice on how to avoid problems. 	Year 10 Exams – Reading, Listening and Writing assessment on all the 4 topics covered so far.
Festivals and Traditions	 By the end of this topic pupils should be able to: Recognise and understand different celebrations in France and compare their celebrations to the UK and other cultures. Talk about how they celebrate birthdays and Christmas using the present tense and say which is their favourite and why. Compare daily routines and use 'devoir', 'pouvoir, and 'vouloir'. Give the advantages and disadvantages and importance of marriage and use the future tense to describe their future plans. 	Speaking Assessment – Photo card and conversation on 2 modules covered so far. One topic chosen by the student.
Town and Region	By the end of this topic pupils should be able to: Use 'depuis', 'y', and 'en' to talk, in detail about the town and region where they live. Compare their hometown to a French town and give the advantages and disadvantages of living in their town. Talk confidently in the past tense about what they did last weekend in their town. Give a description of their ideal town using justified opinions.	End of Topic Assessment – Theme 2, Module 1 – Town and Region. Listening and reading assessment Translation assessment.
