This week many of you will be visiting the Pleasure Beach and ride on the Big One. During peak times there are 3 trains, each with 5 cars, which each sit 6 people. If at peak times 1800 people can ride the Big One in one hour, how many times does one of the trains have to go round the track?

Numeracy Challenge 35 was successfully answered by Reuben Bland from 7 Finch. By looking at the shapes in the diagram, the only 3 digit number that can be made by adding single digits to a double digit number is 111 . After realising this, it is a matter of trial and error to find that the triangles must be 9 , and the squares 6 .
