Dear Parents/Carers

### Reflection

I am pleased to share with you our first weekly reflection, which will be linked to our school prayer theme for the following week.

Ordinary People: "I tell you the truth, whatever you did for one of the least of these brothers of mine, you did for me," Mt. 25:40

Holocaust Memorial Day is celebrated on 27th January and is a time to remember the millions of people murdered during the Nazi persecution and in genocides that followed.

This week we also call to mind some of the actions of ordinary people involved in resistance to the Holocaust, including those who participated in the Kindertransport, which began in December 1938. This 9-month rescue mission secured the transfer of more than 10,000 young people under 17 out of Nazi-occupied countries to places of safety. Ignoring the significant risk to themselves, it was ordinary people; rabbis, business and church leaders and youth organisations, who worked closely together to rescue these children. Most never saw their families again.

Please set aside some time this week to ask God for healing and reconciliation from these sins against humanity. Give thanks for the courage and resilience of the millions of ordinary people who endured unspeakable suffering, and ask that they may overcome the darkness of hatred and bigotry as they turn to the light.
