Try to find the time to put yourself in the place of the disciples on that first Easter morning as the amazing events unfold. What did they feel and think, as their sadness turned to confusion and then confusion turned to joy?

Easter shows us how God loves to bring life out of death, to turn pain to joy. During this season, remember that truth, that through the events of Easter, God promises to transform the pain of life into joy in following him and promises that for us, just like Jesus, death is not the end but the beginning of all God has in store for each one of us.


