In 2015, Pope Francis wrote 'Laudato Si' (or 'praised be' in English), a letter addressed to every person on the planet. Pope Francis tells us that the earth is "God's gift to us, full of beauty and wonder, where the fruits of the earth belong to everyone." The letter discusses the damage being inflicted on our planet by humans, covering a range of environmental issues including pollution, climate change, and access to water. Pope Francis challenges us to create a better world for future generations, and to make urgent changes to our lifestyles to protect and respect our common home.

Sometimes when we think about the problems facing our world, we can feel helpless, but Pope Francis calls upon us all to work together to make a difference, even if only in small ways.
