BEDE Points - recognition of achievement

Following some useful feedback from pupils and parents and carers, we are keen to do even more to acknowledge the achievement of our pupils through BEDE reward points on Class Charts. As you are already aware, we have set up a system which notifies parents/carers when their child reaches various stages of the behaviour system. We are now replicating this system for BEDE reward points, by contacting you to acknowledge when pupils reach various point thresholds.

You will now be notified when your child achieves their first 25 BEDE points, and then again at 50, 100, 150, 200, 250, 300, 250, 400, 450 and 500+ points. These notifications will begin for BEDE points awarded since 15th January 2024, but all points received before this date still count and remain on the system.

We hope that celebrating the achievement of your children in this way will make collaboration between home and school even greater, and continue to develop the positive culture of praise and recognition we always seek to foster.
