
Before your journey


Don't travel if you are unwell

Be familiar with the bus timetable

Arrive at the bus stop in plenty of time



At your bus stop, observe social distancing- keep a 2 metre gap between yourself and others.




What to take with you

- You must bring and wear a face covering which must be worn for the entire journey. Wash your hands before putting it on and taking it off.

Waiting to board the bus

- Remember to try to keep a distance of 2 metres from people where possible.
- Board the bus when the driver is ready and follow his/her instructions about seating arrangements. You must sit where you are instructed to.

On Your Journey




You must maintain 2 metre distance where possible between you and other passengers.

Please use a face covering and wear this for the entire journey.



Be patient and follow instructions from transport staff.



Sanitise your hands as frequently as possible .

On your journey, you must treat the driver with respect and follow his/her instructions. Help to keep yourself, other passengers and the driver safe: This may include taking notice of:

- Notices of which seats to use or how to queue
- Additional screens, barriers or floor markings
- Tape which may be used to indicate which seats you can/cannot use

Help to keep yourself, other passengers and transport staff safe by:

- Respecting other people's space while travelling
- Not consuming food, drink or sweets
- Staying in your seat during the journey
- Being aware of touching surfaces and not touching your face, making sure you cover your mouth or nose by using a tissue when coughing or sneezing.

Asking For Assistance

Ask for assistance if you need it

If any problems arise or you feel ill during your journey, speak to the driver. Report any problems to Mr Barnett (abarnett@stbedeslytham.lancs.sch.uk) In the event of an emergency, contact the emergency services as you normally would.

After your journey

Upon arrival at school, you will be supervised by a member of staff as you enter via the driveway keeping a gap of at least 2 metres between you and other pupils .

Wash your hands for at least 20 seconds or sanitise them using sanitiser gel.
